## Driving Education, Health, and Dignity Through Measurable Action

Bethel Network is a community-centered organization committed to improving education outcomes, strengthening health systems, and restoring dignity for children and families. In 2025, our work focused on delivering practical, sustainable solutions with clear, measurable impact.



This newsletter presents a consolidated snapshot of our 2025 reach across water access, menstrual health, mental wellness, hygiene, and partnerships.

## Access to Safe Drinking Water (ASDW)

Clean water is foundational to health, learning, and dignity. Through ASDW, Bethel Network partnered with schools and communities to implement sustainable water solutions.

2025 Impact Metrics

- 5,921,000 litres of clean and safe water supplied
- Water access provided to schools and households
- Installation and upgrading of water systems using solar-powered solutions
- Improved hygiene standards and reduced water-related illness risks

Reliable water access has contributed directly to improved school attendance, better sanitation practices, and healthier learning environments.



## Always Keeping Girls In School (AKGIS)

Menstrual health remains a critical but often overlooked barrier to education. AKGIS ensures that menstruation does not interrupt learning.

2025 Impact Metrics

- 9 sanitary pads per girl per year, covering the full school calendar
- Menstrual health education delivered alongside product distribution
- Reduced absenteeism linked to menstruation
- Increased confidence and classroom participation among girls

AKGIS supports dignity, attendance, and equal access to education for the girl child.

## Partnership-Led Delivery Model



Bethel Network's impact is driven through collaboration.

## SHIFT Program – Life Skills & Mental Wellness

Education extends beyond academics. Through SHIFT (Shaping, Helping, Inspiring, Fostering, and Transforming Lives), Bethel Network focuses on mental wellness and life skills development.

### 2025 Impact Metrics

- SHIFT sessions delivered in primary and secondary schools
- Students trained in:
  - Mental wellness and emotional regulation
  - Life skills and self-awareness
  - Leadership and positive decision-making
- Teachers report improved student confidence, behavior, and peer interaction

SHIFT creates safe spaces where learners develop resilience and a strong sense of self.



## Hygiene & Health Support – Pwani Schools Activation

In partnership with Pwani Oil, Bethel Network supported hygiene and sanitation efforts in schools.

### 2025 Impact Metrics

- Soap distributed to students in participating schools
- Hygiene education sessions conducted
- Improved handwashing practices and school cleanliness

This initiative strengthened daily hygiene habits and reduced preventable health risks among learners.

- Scaling access to safe drinking water
- Expanding menstrual health coverage
- Deepening mental wellness programming
- Strengthening cross-sector partnerships
